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#### **SIGNING-ON**

Signing-on will take place at Plas Arthur Leisure Centre, Penrallt, Llangefni, LL77 7QX. Map Ref. 114/453.5 758.5

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Signing-on opens at 17:00 hours and closes at 20:30 hours on Saturday, 15th February 2025. You need to produce your valid Motorsport UK competition licence (minimum grade RS Clubman), club membership card, and insurance policy document.

#### **ENTRY FORM**

Please ensure that we have all the necessary details on your entry form. The name on the entry form must match the name on your competition licence. Names and contact details of Next of Kin are often overlooked. To check or update your entry form, go to your entry Acknowledgement email and use the link <u>Access Your Entry Home Page</u>

#### **MARSHALS**

Signing-on for marshals opens at 17:00 hours and closes at 20.30 hours on Saturday, 15th February 2025. To book your marshal's place, please contact Rob Jos on **07586 614637** (No Phone Calls after 9pm)

Your marshal is your responsibility; please ensure they have:

- Suitable pens, clipboards and high visibility clothing, torch and a hammer to knock in control boards.
- Bin bag to take away their rubbish.
- Ensure your marshal understands where they are going and what they are doing.

- As stated in the SRs, all competing crews must provide a marshal(s) to cover at least one control and they MUST sign-on with ONE competing crew only unless booked in advance.
- You are reminded that no named official can be signed on as a marshal.
- If the marshal who has signed on for a competitor does not turn up at a control or leaves the control area before the arrival of the closing car, or is reported for driving in a manner likely to bring the sport into disrepute, the associated competitor will be disqualified from the results.
- The Chief Marshal/Timekeeper will issue marshals who are allocated time controls with an official clock. The clock must be handed to the closing car or a club official once the control is closed.
- Should these clocks be damaged or go missing the competitor associated with that marshal will be held responsible for the cost of replacing or repairing that clock.

Remember ...... NO MARSHAL = NO START.

#### **Controls**

We aim to man all Passage Controls (PC) & Time Controls (TC), however, if for some reason a control is not manned, the organisers reserve the right to replace this with a Route Check (RC) in the form of a code board. Such boards will be on display at the start. If a board is present, crews must record the code in the appropriate box and it must be verified at the next manned control (excluding DSO's, Secret Checks).

#### **Fuel**

Please ensure that you have put fuel in your vehicle before you arrive at the start venue as you will not be allowed to leave once scrutineering, etc. have been completed. Fuel will be available at Herron Services, Glanhwfa Rd, Llangefni LL77 7EY.

Ensure you carry enough fuel to cover approximately 45 miles.

There will be a petrol halt at halfway before your time recovery.

#### **INSURANCE**

Unfortunately, the motor club has been unable to secure a blanket cover for the event and therefore, all competitors will need to ensure that they have the correct insurance cover for rallying on the public highway in compliance with the Road Traffic Act, and that the insurance policy document is available to confirm the name of the insurer at the start of the event.

Best Presented Car (will be presented at the drivers' briefing)

Highest Place Mixed Crew: Awards to driver and navigator of the highest placed mixed crew and not winning an overall or class award

1st Lady Driver – Awarded to the highest placed lady driver not winning an overall or class award

1st Lady Navigator - Awarded to the highest placed car lady navigator not winning an overall or class award.

Up to 1400 Capacity Cars: Awards to driver and navigator of the highest placed car of up to and including 1400 c.c. capacity not winning an overall or class award.

#### **DRIVING STANDARDS / ROAD TRAFFIC ACT**

Reminder to all competitors of Section 170 of the Road Traffic Act 1988 and Rule 286 of the Highway Code. Please remember to drive safely and show respect for residents, marshals, and spectators.

#### **DAMAGE DECLARATION**

All competitors are required to complete a damage declaration form to be handed in at the finish or, in the case of retirement, forwarded to the Entries Secretary within 72 hours. Failure to do so will result in a competitor being reported to Motorsport UK and Club committee.


