Thank you for your entry to the Pant Glas Body Repairs, JJ Brown Memorial Road Rally 2025. Your entry number is as per the provisional entry list online at –

Please see the plan below for location of the trailer park, noise test and scrutineering.

A reminder that both members of your crew need to comply with certain important requirements.

- 1) SIGNING-ON – Signing-on will take place in the Main Hall, Ysgol Dyffryn Nantlle, Penygroes. (115/473¾ 532) Signing-on closes at **20.30 hours on Saturday, 18<sup>th</sup> January 2025**. You need to produce your valid Motorsport UK competition licence, club membership card, and insurance policy document.
- 2) CLUB MEMBERSHIP - If you need to apply for membership, go to [www.camconline.co.uk](http://www.camconline.co.uk).
- 3) ENTRY FORM – Please ensure that we have all the necessary details on your entry form. The name on the entry form must match the name on your competition licence. Names and contact details of Next of Kin are often overlooked. To check or update your entry form, go to <https://mtc1.uk/Entry/JJBrown25/EntryList.php>.
- 4) MARSHALS –Signing-on for marshals closes at 20.30 hours on Saturday, 18<sup>th</sup> January 2025, but it would be in everyone's interest to have this done as soon as possible.

All competitors must have a valid Motorsport UK RS Interclub (or higher grade) competition licence, Motor Club membership card, and Insurance Policy Document.

Scrutineering will be located at Beespeed, Unit 1G, Cibyn Industrial Estate, Caernarfon, LL55 2BD; O.S. Map 115; Reference 494 $\frac{3}{4}$  626 $\frac{3}{4}$ .

Trailer parking is available at Cibyn Industrial Estate, Caernarfon, LL55 2BD - O.S. Map 115; Reference 496 $\frac{1}{2}$  627 $\frac{1}{2}$  (park your trailer at own risk) Overflow car park available please ask marshall in Trailer Park.

#### **Information**

##### **Trailer Park (see location plan)**

- Trailer parking is at Cibyn Industrial Estate, Caernarfon, LL552BD: Map Ref 115/496 $\frac{1}{2}$  627 $\frac{1}{2}$ . Please follow the marshals' instructions.
- Please park sensibly and **DO NOT** block the entrance. Vehicles are left at owners' risk & C&A Motor Club cannot guarantee security of your property.
- Trailers are not to be loaded in Pant Ddu/Penygroes following the event.

##### **Petrol**

- Please ensure that you have put fuel in your vehicle before you arrive at the start venue as you will not be allowed to leave once scrutineering etc. have been completed.

- Ensure you carry enough fuel to cover 80 miles, but an optional fuel halt will be available after 40 miles.

#### Noise Test (see location plan)

- Only the two crew members to go with the car to Noise Test.
- Map Ref 115/496 $\frac{1}{2}$  624 $\frac{1}{4}$ .
- **OPENS – 16:00 hours / CLOSSES PROMPTLY – 20:00 hours.**
- Pick up process card – proceed to scrutineering, see below.

#### Scrutineering (see location plan)

- Only the two crew members to go with the car to scrutineering.
- Beespeed, Unit 1G, Cibyn Industrial Estate: Map Ref 115/494 $\frac{3}{4}$  626 $\frac{3}{4}$ .
- The original test centre MOT certificate must be produced
- **OPENS – 16:00 hours / CLOSSES – 20:00 hours.**
- **STRICTLY NO SPECTATORS IN SCRUTINEERING**

After successfully passing scrutineering please make your way to Ysgol Dyffryn Nantlle, Penygroes (115/473 $\frac{3}{4}$  532) park your vehicle as directed by the marshal & proceed to the signing-on area within the main building.

#### Signing-on

- Only the two crew members, plus their Marshal to attend signing on.
- Please attend marshals signing-on before competitors signing-on.  
(note: **NO MARSHAL= NO START**).
- **OPENS – 16:30 hours / CLOSSES – 20:30 hours**
- Competitors should present their process card from Noise Test and Scrutineering to collect their pack.
- There will be a map check during signing-on, please bring all your maps to signing-on.

You will be supplied with two Rally Plates. Adhere one to the rear screen and the other to the nearside rear side window.

#### Drivers Briefing

Both crew members must attend the drivers briefing, this will take place at 21:00 in the Main Hall, Ysgol Dyffryn Nantlle, Penygroes. (115/473 $\frac{3}{4}$  532)

#### Competition Licences

May we remind everyone that you will need a 2025 Motorsport UK Competition Licence of RS Interclub grade or higher (NOT the Free RS Clubman!) Please make sure you have familiarised yourself with the Motorsport UK Sport:80 licence platform and made arrangements to renew your licence and that it will arrive in good time. Alternatively, you can complete the competition licence application application form, present a FULLY completed form, with payment, stamped and addressed envelope, on the night. PLEASE do not contact the Clerk of the Course or anyone else from the organising team with licence queries. ## Route

- Standard sections will be run at an average speed of 30mph.
- Masters & Experts will collect the Route Information from MC0 at 21:30 hours plus your start number in minutes.  
Semi-Experts & Novices: The first Semi-Expert will collect the Route Information from MC0 at 21:30 hours followed by the remaining Semi-Experts & Novices in numeric order at 1 minute intervals.
- Your start time at MC1 is 23:30 hours plus your start number in minutes
- The time recorded at all Time Controls will be when the competitor presents their time card to the marshal.
- You MUST adhere to quiet areas and Non-Competitive areas by switching off your spotlights and engaging the highest gear possible to minimize noise.
- You are reminded that all forward motion must cease at Give Way junctions on competitive sections.
- DSO's will be utilized to observe and record their findings at various points on the route.
- **A huge amount of work and effort has been undertaken by the Pant Glas Body Repairs J.J. Brown Memorial Rally team to secure the use of some PR sensitive areas. To enable us to maintain the future use of these areas we would ask that you adhere closely to the instructions in the route information regarding Quiet areas and Non-Competitive areas.**

## Marshals

Remember, the rule of '**NO MARSHAL = NO START**' will be strictly adhered to.

- Marshal signing-on **OPENS 16:30hours / CLOSSES 20.30 hours.**
- Your marshal is your responsibility; please ensure they have:
  - **Suitable pens, clipboards and high visibility clothing, torch and a hammer to knock in control boards.**
  - **Bin bag to take away their rubbish.**
- Ensure your marshal understands where they are going and what they are doing.
- As stated in the SRs, all competing crews must provide a marshal(s) to cover at least one control and they MUST sign-on with **ONE** competing crew only unless booked in advance.
- You are reminded that **no named official can be signed on as a marshal.**
- If the marshal who has signed on for a competitor does not turn up at a control or leaves the control area before the arrival of the closing car, or is reported for driving in a manner likely to bring the sport into disrepute, the associated competitor will be disqualified from the results.
- The Chief Marshal/Timekeeper will issue marshals who are allocated time controls with an official clock. The clock must be handed to the closing car or a club official once the control is closed.
- Should these clocks be damaged or go missing the competitor associated with that marshal will be held responsible for the cost of replacing or repairing that clock.

- Marshals Booking for anyone wishing to man one control will open at **2pm on Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> January 2025**. This will be by TEXT only (**NOT** WhatsApp or Messenger) to Dylan Jones, our Chief Marshal, on 07867 520875 Stating 1) Marshals Name 2) Entered Drivers Name 3) State either Time or Passage Control

### Controls

We aim to man all Passage Controls (PC) & Time Controls (TC), however, if for some reason a control is not manned, the organisers reserve the right to replace this with a Route Check (RC) in the form of a code board. Such boards will be on display at the start. If a board is present, crews must record the code in the appropriate box and it must be verified at the next manned control (excluding DSO's, Secret Checks).

### General Information

- Competitors are reminded of the requirement of Section 170 of the Road Traffic Act to report any incident involving injury to a third party to North Wales Police.

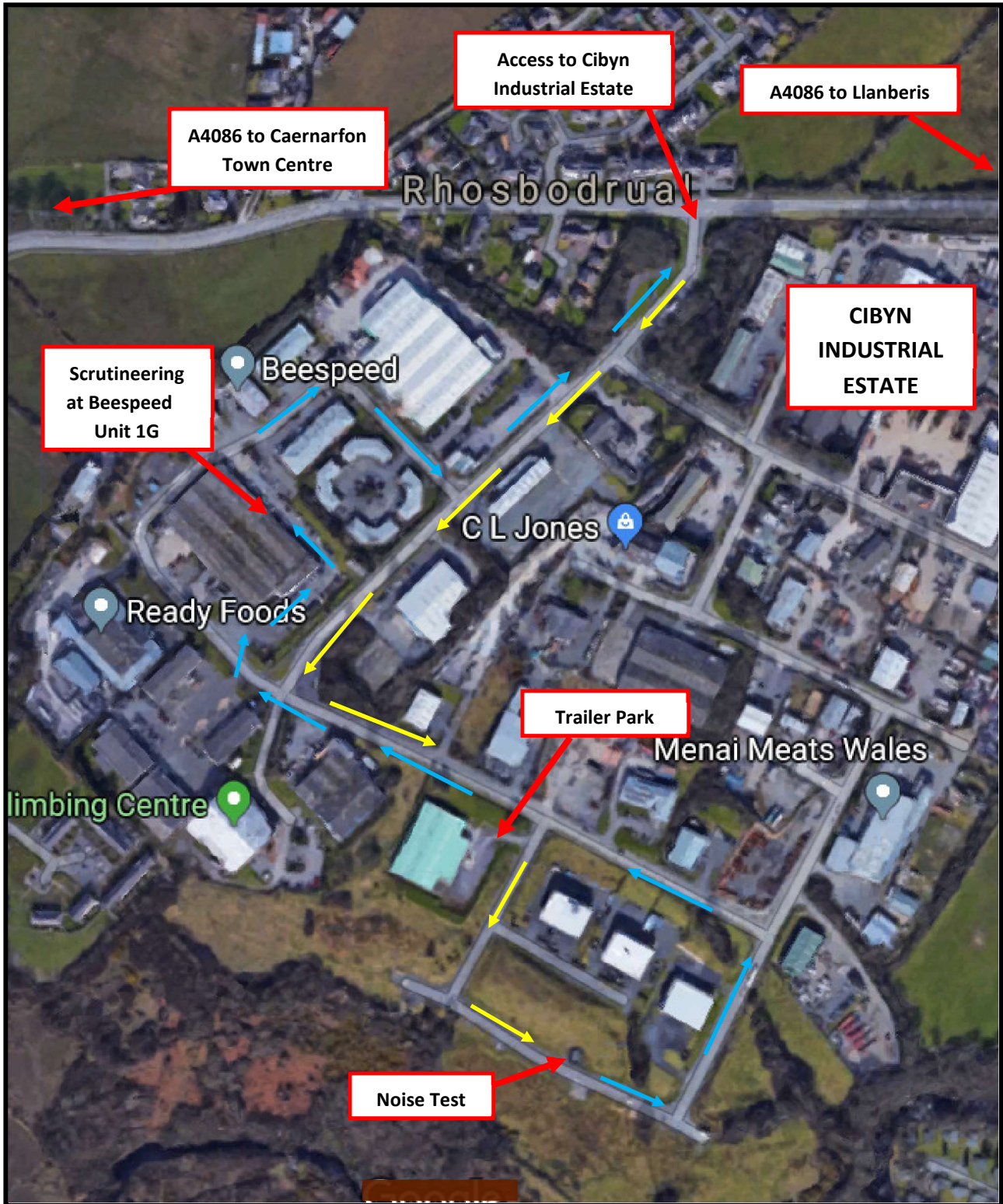
