## Stuff The Turkey PCA

28<sup>th</sup> December 2024

### Final Instructions

Thank you for your entry for this year's Stuff The Turkey PCA. Your competitor number will be allocated to you at signing-on.

Report to Signing-on in the ground floor of the tower (see diagram below), which opens at **9:00am** and closes at **10:00am**. Have your Competition Licence and Club Card ready for inspection. Sign-on. Printed copies of the test diagrams will be available, and your first timecard will be issued, along with a competition number for the windscreen.

Competitors may then "walk the tests".

There will be a driver's briefing at **10:15am**, near signing-on.

The first car will start at approximately **10:30am**.

There will be two rounds of four test sites before a lunch break of approximately 30 minutes, followed by a further two rounds (time permitting). The event should finish at around 3.30pm to 4pm.

Please be aware that the worst score for a competitor at each test site will be dropped from the overall results.



## **DUAL ENTRIES**

For those sharing a vehicle: - Once the first driver has completed a Test, the car should be handed over to the second driver and go to the start line of the same Test by jumping any queue. We will try to alternate competition numbers of dual entries (e.g., car number 1 & 3), to keep the event flowing.

## **RUNNING OF TESTS**

There will be four Test sites (A, B, C and D) and competitors will be divided into four groups. Each group will attempt four runs at a Test and then move on to the next site in order, until all competitors have completed four runs at each Test. For example, Group 1 will start at Test A and after completing four runs, will move on to Test B, and so on

## **Additions and Amendments to the Supplementary Regulations**

### **7. CLASSES**

Open top or Sports cars may compete with their hoods down or a hard top removed provided the passenger/navigator is 16 years old or over and at least 135cm in height.

### **13. RESULTS.**

The worst score for a competitor at each test site will be dropped from the overall results.

### **14. AWARDS.**

There will be awards allocated to both crew members for:

Fastest Time of the Day (1<sup>st</sup> overall).

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in class A.

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in class B.
