Once onto Anglesey, exit the A55 at Junction 5 for the A4080 and follow brown chequered flag signs for Race Circuit. Please note there are no local petrol stations near the venue. The closest is in Gaerwen, just off junction 7 of the A55 (LL60 6HL). There is a convenience (Spar) store on the A4080 at Llanfaelog, en-route to the venue.

PROCEDURE – see plan below.

Access the circuit through the Main Gate, then take the first gateway on the right, along the Spectator Access Road, towards the Medical Centre and Circuit Office.

On arrival park as directed (see diagram). You can keep your trailer with your tow vehicles and car in the parking area. **PLEASE DO NOT PARK ON THE GRASS.**

Once unloaded please report to the Circuit Office for signing-on.

Please remember your club membership cards, competition licence and any outstanding payments.

The scrutineer will come round to your car. Main things are battery and seat security, brakes and steering.

There are two events taking place, a PCA and an Autotest, both doing the same test diagrams.

Signing on and scrutineering starts at **09:00 hours** and ends at **10:00 hours**.

Driver's briefing will be in the signing on office at 10:15 hours.

First test to commence at **10:30 hours.** The number and order of tests will be decided by the CoC on the day. Competitors will be permitted to walk the tests before 10:30.

The entry will be split up into groups, where each group will start on one of the three test sites and complete four runs at that test. Drivers can then take a short break to allow the marshals time for a break, before drivers move onto the next test site and do four runs at that. Then another break before moving to their final test site.

The last test will be at approx. 16:00 hours.

The event requires a great number of volunteer marshals. If you are not competing but are willing to marshal, please report to the signing on area before 10:15 hours.
